


FTSE4Good BIVA Index

The FTSE4Good BIVA Index has been designed to measure the performance of liquid Mexican companies demonstrating strong Environmental, Social and Governance (ESG) practices. In order to be included, companies must be in both the FTSE BIVA Index, which includes constituents of the FTSE Mexico All Cap Index that pass certain liquidity criteria, and the FTSE4Good Emerging Index, which includes constituents of the FTSE BIVA index, which includes that pass the FTSE4Good ESG selection criteria.

Transparency

Criteria

Objective

The index is designed for use in the creation of index tracking funds, derivatives and as a performance benchmark.

Investability

Stocks in the underlying index are selected and weighted to ensure that the index is investable.

Liquidity

Stocks in the underlying index are screened to ensure that the index is tradable.

Availability

The index is calculated based on price and total return methodologies, available end-ofday.

Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB)

Index constituents are categorised in accordance with the Industry Classification Benchmark (ICB), the global standard for industry sector analysis.
